Observation

Observation: What does it say?

- 1. What do you notice about the text? Things to look for:
 - repeating words and phrases
 - Answers to the questions: who, what, when, where and how?
 - contrasts and comparaisons
 - similes and metaphors (images used it the text)
 - cause and effect relationships
 - details regarding: time, geography, place, people, action in the text
 - grammer
 - larger themes in the passage
 - key words and themes
- 2. What questions do you have?

Interpretation

- 1. What do you think it means for Paul to be a *servant of the gospel* (verses 23 and 25)?
- Paul talks about a mystery in verse 26 and 27. How would you define the word mystery? What is the mystery that Paul is talking about, and how might it be similar or different from how we usually understand this word? (See <u>Romans 16:25-27</u>, <u>Ephesians</u> <u>6:19</u>, <u>1 Tim 3:16</u> and <u>Revelation 10:7</u>).
- 3. What do you think *Christ in you* means in this passage (verse 27)?

Interpretation

The goal here is to answer questions raised by the text and to get at the central message of the passage itself.

What did the text mean for the original audience?

How might you summarize the central point of the passage?

Application

- What does being a servant of the gospel mean for us today?
- 2. What is the good news for us from this passage?
