Read [Mark 11: 1-18](#)

1. The book of Zechariah provides some important background to the Mark 11 passage. Compare Zechariah 14:1-21 and Zechariah 9:9-10. How are they similar? How are they different?
2. In Mark 11:1-7, why did Jesus choose to enter Jerusalem in such a specific way? What does this show about how he sees himself?
3. What does the crowd's reaction to Jesus reveal about their expectation of him?
4. A knowledge of Scripture, particularly of the Old Testament, was important to Jesus' understanding of himself and his mission. Do you think that our understanding of Scripture shapes how we see ourselves? If so, how?
5. There are many voices in our world that call for our attention. Do you think that it's possible for what God says, through Scripture, to be the loudest voice that we hear? What practices or habits might help?
