

Sermon Discussion Questions

We encourage you to use these for personal study or for small group conversations around the sermon text. You can meet over the phone or online with one or two other people to go through these questions and to pray together.

1. Read [Luke 24:44-53](#). What stands out to you in this passage? What questions do you have as you read?
2. From the sermon, what happened at the Ascension and how does this impact our lives today? Take a look at [Romans 8:34](#) and [Hebrews 4:14-16](#) if you need a reminder.
3. Why is Pentecost the 'essential complement' to the Ascension?
4. Today, do you think that we put more emphasis on the Ascension or more emphasis on Pentecost (are we more Christ centred or more Spirit focused)? How can you tell? Why do we need both of these?
5. In verses 52 and 53, the people respond with great joy. Gordon Smith points out that as we learn to focus on Jesus, in dependence on the Spirit, we turn from fear to joy. Why does this sometimes seem challenging? Practically, how can we learn to live this way?
6. How might remembering God's reign, and that Jesus is at work in our world today, shape how you see your circumstances this week? In what areas of your life would you like to invite the Spirit to be at work this week?
