POSITION TITLE: Children and Preteens Ministries' Intern

SUMMARY:

Being a part of the internship program at First Baptist Church, the Children and Preteen Ministries' Intern is accountable and directly supervised by the Director of Children & Preteen Ministries. He or she is to serve alongside the Director in relation to the overall vision, values, and programming of this ministry. This position is a 10 hour a week position with Sunday morning participation a critical part of the role. The goal of this internship will be to provide hands on experience for the intern, as well as the creation of a new worship initiative for the children's ministry at First Baptist Church.

The intern will be given the opportunity to develop and coach a team of volunteer leaders and assist with programs in the following areas:

Programming:

- The C&P Intern will be responsible for developing, coordinating, and directing a worship initiative for Early Childhood and School-Age children.
- The C&P Intern will participate in hands on teaching for Early Childhood and Schoolage(SA) children.
- The C&P Intern will support the planning efforts involved for the special events that Children and Preteen ministries leads every year. This includes:

Christmas Eve Family Service

Palm Sunday Processional

Year-end special activities and events

Leadership development responsibilities:

- Assist the Director in developing leaders related to early childhood and school-aged children.
- Develop and Coach a team to help lead a worship time for children monthly
- Lead worship times for children
- Assist in the recruiting and training of leaders to minister to children
- Encourage a dedicated team structure and team philosophy to children's ministry.
- Provide direct supervision of staff (paid and volunteer) in our programs.
- Participate in training initiatives designed for the development of Children and Preteen Ministries Leaders.
