#### **A PRAYER FOR ADVENT II**

O Root of Jesse, Which stands for a sign of the people, at Whom rulers shall shut their mouths, and to Whom the nations shall pray: come now and set us free, and no longer delay. Amen.

The past, present and future collide within this prayer, as Jesus Christ is acknowledged as the Root (foundation) and Branch (fulfillment) of Jesse. Jesse was the father of King David, a lowly shepherd who became one of the greatest of the kings of Israel, a man after God's own heart. Through David's line, God had promised that a King would come, someone greater than David, who would be a shepherd not only to Israel but the nations, finally fulfilling God's great plan of salvation. In the book of Revelation, Jesus, himself, says, "I am the Root and the Offspring of David." As we pray this prayer, let's rejoice that God has sent His Son to fulfill His rescue plan for the world, calling all nations to look to Jesus, the foundation and fulfillment of His salvation.
